- Transfer entire repository of approximately 50,000 pieces of digital content -- courses, units, lesson plans, and learning object resources
- Migrate 11,000 teachers from an existing technology used every day to access missioncritical instructional resources
- Integration of new system with an existing, mandatory textbook adoption process and new lesson plans generated each year by a variety of publishers
- Transition district-level curriculum staff to the new application with confidence
- Getting buy-in from stakeholders for a new system, when current system has been successfully used for nearly a decade


Challenges


